Abu-Ghazaleh Wins OSCAR 'Most Prominent Arab Scientific Personality of the Year 2020' Education Award



AMMAN – HE Dr. Talal Abu-Ghazaleh, founder and chairman of Talal Abu-Ghazaleh Global (TAG. Global), won the OSCAR Education Award as "The Most Prominent Arab Scientific Personality for 2020". The award contest was organized by the Human Development Training Center (HDTC) in Dubai, the UAE.

The selection of winners was based on a six-day survey conducted by the Center, where Dr. Abu-Ghazaleh received the highest number of votes of more than quarter of a million voting participants from 70 countries.

The Center announced that the winners will be virtually honored on February 17, 2021, in a ceremony that gathers a host of high-ranking personalities.

IFAC completed its inaugural series—exploring the IESBA Code—a unique, educational resource developed in collaboration with the staff of the International Ethics Standards Board for Accountants (IESBA). Launched in November 2019, each installment of the series highlights important concepts and topics in the International Code of Ethics for Professional Accountants (including International Independence Standards).

The final installment, explains the "building structure of the Code and This installment is interconnected nature. intended to help readers better understand how to use and navigate the Code so that they can quickly identify and access the ethics and independence standards and guidance relevant to them. Other topics covered in the series include: the fundamental principles, the conceptual framework, auditor independence, conflicts of interest, inducements, non-compliance with laws and regulations (NOCLAR), pressure, and the role and mindset expected of the professional accountant with a focus on bias.

"The Exploring the IESBA Code series is a very useful tool to complement the IESBA eCode," said Dr. Stavros Thomadakis, IESBA Chairman. "Each installment provides a summary of important aspects of the Code with cues on how to read and apply its authoritative text. This final installment spotlights the purpose of the Code, how it is structured, and how it should be used—by accountants in business (PAIBs) and public practice (PAPPs), including auditors. The successful completion of this initiative demonstrates once again how IESBA's and IFAC's partnership is valuable in supporting the global adoption and implementation of the Code."

IFAC's CEO, Kevin Dancey, said "The ethical foundation of the accountancy profession is one of its most important features. The Exploring the IESBA Code series demonstrates IFAC's commitment to this ethical foundation and our role in supporting the important work of IESBA, as well as the International Auditing and Assurance Standards Board (IAASB) and International Public Sector Accounting Standards Board (IPSASB). I encourage professional accountancy our members, organizations and national standard setters around the world to leverage this new resource to help raise awareness of the Code and to help professional accountants uphold their public interest responsibility."

IFAC and ICAEW Release Fifth Installment of Six-Part Anti-**Money Laundering Educational Series**

Together with ICAEW, The International Federation of Accountants (IFAC) released the fifth installment in its Anti-Money Laundering: The Basics educational series: Installment 5: Tax Advice

The publication is part of a 6-month short series helping accountants enhance their understanding of how money laundering works, the risks they face, and what they can do to mitigate these risks and make a positive contribution to the public interest. Installment five examines tax advice and the multiple ways in which tax services may be vulnerable to money laundering.

The installment series, with its focus on accessibility and ease of use, will be a resource for Small and Medium Practices (SMPs,) and accountants less familiar with AML, while also providing guidance for those looking for a quick refresher or reference.



Anti-Money Laundering: The Basics is featured on both the IFAC (landing page) and ICAEW websites and available for download for free. To be globally relevant, the series uses the riskbased approach of the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) the global money laundering and terrorist financing watchdog -- as a starting point.

IASB amends IFRS Standards to improve accounting policy disclosures and clarify distinction between accounting policies and accounting estimates

The International Accounting Standards Board (Board) has issued narrow-scope amendments to IFRS Standards.

The amendments will help companies:

- Improve accounting policy disclosures so that they provide more useful information to investors and other primary users of the financial statements; and
- Distinguish changes in accounting estimates from changes in accounting policies.

Following feedback that more guidance was needed to help companies decide what accounting policy information should be disclosed, the Board has today issued amendments to IAS 1 Presentation of Financial Statements and IFRS Practice Statement 2 Making Materiality



Judgements. The amendments to IAS 1 require companies to disclose their material accounting policy information rather than their significant accounting policies. The amendments to IFRS Practice Statement 2 provide guidance on how to apply the concept of materiality to accounting policy disclosures.

Separately, Board has also issued the

amendments to IAS 8 Accounting Policies, Changes in Accounting Estimates and Errors. The amendments clarify how companies should distinguish changes in accounting policies from changes in accounting estimates. That distinction is important because changes in accounting estimates are applied prospectively only to future transactions and other future events, but changes in accounting policies are generally

also applied retrospectively to past transactions and other past events.

The amendments to IAS 1 and IAS 8 will be effective for annual reporting periods beginning on or after 1 January 2023, with early application permitted.




